

Memory Verse Opportunities

Each BLAST class has three memory verse sheets specific to their grade/group. Once they complete their first verse sheet, there are second and third verse sheets they can complete.

Memory Verse Points and Awards can be earned as follows:

- **BLAST Store Points:** Points will be awarded as stated on the verse sheets per verse or set of verses.
- **Memory Verse Medal:** Our BLAST Kids will receive the Memory Verse medal when they complete the first memory verse sheet specific to their grade/group.
- **Memory Verse All Star Award:** Our BLAST Kids will receive the Memory Verse trophy when they complete the first and second memory verse sheets specific to their grade/group. These kids also earn an End of the Year Pizza Party!
- **Memory Verse Champion Award:** Our BLAST Kids will receive this trophy when they complete the third memory verse sheet and recite it to a pastor, an elder or member of the CE Committee. They will also receive an additional 100 BLAST points. The Memory Verse Champion Trophy will be awarded at the BLAST Celebration Ceremony!

This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: you shall love your neighbor as yourself.*

Proverbs 15:1 *A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.*

Third Verse Sheet **(For all grades/groups)**

These verses can be memorized and recited after the entire first and second verse sheets are completed. Points will be awarded for each section as listed below. If all the verses on this sheet are memorized and recited to a pastor, an elder, or a CE Committee member, the student will receive 100 additional BLAST points and be awarded the Memory Verse Champion Trophy at the BLAST Celebration Ceremony.

Ephesians 1:3-6 *Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved. (20 points)*

Ephesians 2:1-10 *And you were dead in the trespasses and sins in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience – among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ – by grace you have been saved – and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is a gift of God not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. (40 points)*

Ephesians 4:1-6 *I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit – just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call – one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all. (20 points)*

Ephesians 4:17-24 *Now this say and testify in the Lord, that you must no longer walk as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds. They are darkened in their understanding, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, due to their hardness of heart. They have become callous and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedy to practice every kind of impurity. But that is not the way you learned Christ! – assuming that you have heard about him and were taught in him, as the truth is in Jesus, to put off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life, and is corrupt through deceitful desires, and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds, and to put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness. (30 points)*

Ephesians 5:1-2 *Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. (10 points)*

Third Verse Sheet
(For all grades/groups)

Ephesians 5:15-17 *Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but know what the will of the Lord is.*

(10 points)
