- September 27** **Mission Moment:** A flyer will be sent home detailing Operation Christmas Child. Filled boxes and individual items can be brought to BLAST each Wednesday Night through October 25th.
- October 28** **BLAST Fall Festival is on Saturday from 3-5 pm:** Come in a church-appropriate costume. There will be carnival games, face painting, a bounce house, wagon rides, and more! Parents must accompany their children to this event. More information will be sent out at the beginning of October.
- November 1** **Mission Moment:** Learn about the missions and missionaries that Cross Pointe Church supports.
